If the formatting isn't beautiful don't worry, as long as a "good start" on all four pieces is there, she'll be thrilled:

- java code for the business logic,
- database design (a list of the tables you'll need, with the column names, and some sample data)
- HTML code of "sample screens" for input and output
- a paragraph or so of explanation on how it all fits together (i.e. how users interact with the system.)
