Background

- Project Responder sponsored by the Oklahoma City Memorial Institute for the Prevention of Terrorism (MIPT) and Department of Homeland Security (DHS) - October 2003
 - Project Responder, through a series of surveys and focus groups, reached out to the responder community to find what their needs were (specifically equipment). Results indicated that a trusted knowledge base for emergency responders was necessary.





What is the RKB?

The RKB is the Emergency Responder Decision Support Tool


- **Products** module (with over 7,000 records) answers "What equipment is out there?"
- Certifications and Standards modules answer
 "Has it been certified and if so, to what standard?"
- Training module answers

 "What training is needed to use the equipment?"
- FEMA Preparedness Grants and Other Grants modules answer "What grant vehicles exist to purchase the equipment?"
- User Opinions answers

 "Is there anyone in the community that I can talk to who has used the equipment?"

RKB Funding: Funding is provided by the FEMA National Preparedness Directorate.







RKB Users

- Over 75,000 registered users
- Public Users
 - Access to the majority of information on the RKB
- Responders
 - Access to public information, as well as access to limited distribution products, publications, trainings, etc.
- Federal Government
 - Access to all published information on the RKB
 - Ability to share relevant information with the responder community, for example with news items





RKB Users (Continued)

Equipment Purchasers

- Determine whether products are certified to a standard
- Use the comparison feature
- Stay abreast of new technologies

FEMA Grant Applicants

- Access to the Authorized Equipment List (AEL): "The Authorized Equipment List is produced by the FEMA Grant Programs Directorate, (DHS). It is the generic list of equipment items allowable under several FEMA Preparedness grant programs."
- Determine AEL categories applicable to specific grants
 - FEMA Preparedness Grants & AEL module provides a list of applicable AEL categories for each FEMA grant
 - ➤ State Administrative Agents (SAAs) provide assistance with choosing proper AEL category



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

FY2010 Buffer Zone Protection Program (BZPP)

BZPP provides funding to increase the preparedness capabilities of jurisdictions responsible for the safety and security of communities surrounding high-priority pre-designated Tier 1 and Tier 2 critical infrastructure and key resource (CIKR) assets.

FY2010 Driver's License Security Grant Program (DLSGP)

DLSGP is intended to address a key recommendation of the 9/11 Commission to improve the integrity and security of state-issued driver's licenses (DL) and identification cards (ID).

FY2010 Emergency Management Performance Grants (EMPG)

The purpose of the FY 2010 EMPG is to assist state and local governments in enhancing and sustaining all-hazards emergency management capabilities.

FY2010 Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Grant Program

The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Grant Program is intended to improve emergency management and preparedness capabilities by supporting flexible, sustainable, secure, and interoperable Emergency Operations Centers (EOCs) with a focus on addressing identified deficiencies and needs.

FY2010 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP)

This core assistance program provides funds to build capabilities at the state and local levels and to implement the goals and objectives included in state homeland security strategies and initiatives in their State Preparedness Report.

Citizen Corps Program (CCP)

The Citizen Corps mission is to bring community and government leaders together to coordinate community involvement in emergency preparedness, planning, mitigation, response and recovery.

Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) Program

The MMRS program supports the integration of emergency management, health, and medical systems into a coordinated response to mass casualty incidents caused by any hazard.

Operation Stonegarden Grant Program (OPSG)

The intent of OPSG is to enhance cooperation and coordination among local, state and federal law enforcement agencies in a joint mission to secure the United States borders along routes of ingress from international borders to include travel corridors in states bordering Mexico and Canada, as well as states and territories with international water borders.

State Homeland Security Program (SHSP)

This core assistance program provides funds to build capabilities at the state and local levels and to implement the goals and objectives included in state homeland security strategies and initiatives in their State Preparedness Report.

Summary: The purpose of the FY 2010 EMPG is to assist state and local governments in enhancing and sustaining all-hazards

emergency management capabilities.



Objectives

The purpose of the FY2010 EMPG is to assist State and local governments in enhancing and sustaining all-hazards emergency management capabilities. States have the opportunity to use EMPG funds to further strengthen their ability to support emergency management mission areas while simultaneously addressing issues of national concern as identified in the National Priorities of the National Preparedness Guidelines.

Deadlines

Completed applications must be submitted no later than 11:59 p.m. EST, January 22, 2010. Eligible applicants must apply for funding through the Grants gov portal, accessible on the Internet at http://www.grants.gov.

Eligibility

All 56 states and territories, as well as the Republic of the Marshall Islands and the Federated States of Micronesia, are eligible to apply for FY 2010 EMP6 funds. Either the State Administrative Agency (SAA) or the state's Emergency Management Agency (EMA) are eligible to apply directly to <u>FEMA</u> for EMP6 funds on behalf of and local emergency management agencies, however only one application will be accepted from each state or territory.
