"Live life like you mean it" -- Two unlikely friends find out what it takes to be truly free

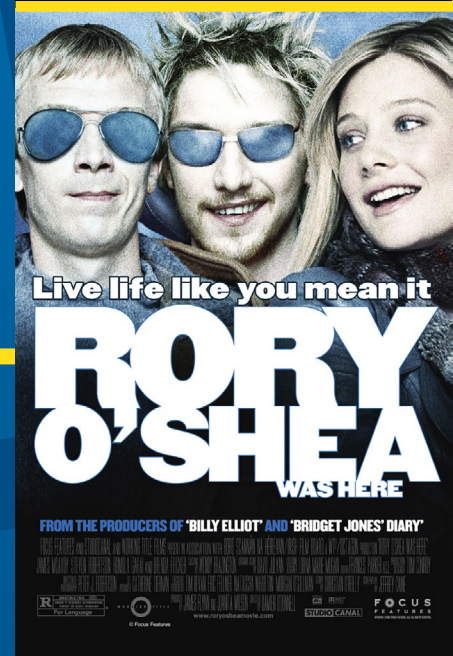
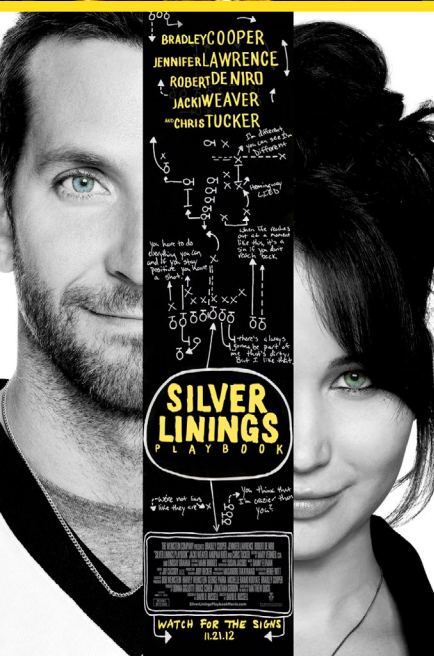
