How Other Schools are Using Panopto

Record Lectures and Labs



- Allow students to re-watch lectures to understand difficult concepts
- Allow absent students to see what they missed
- Easily review for tests
- Start your own recordings or schedule for a hands-free experience.



Flip the Classroom



- More time for in class discussion and activities
- Increases interactions between students and instructors
- 71% of teachers who flipped their classes noticed improved grades, and 80% reported improved student attitudes as a result.

Make Assignments Interactive



- Have students record video
- Add quizzes to your video

Make Video Available on Mobile



- Apps for iOS and Android
- Upload video into the library easily from your device
- Search for and watch video from anywhere

Uploading Video

- Click on Create > Upload Media
- Drag files into window or click to find on computer.
- Most video file types can be added.

- 1. Go to Panopto > Preferences.
- 2. Select primary video quality.
- 3. Select secondary video quality.
- 4. Can optimize for motion quality (fps) or resolution.

User Roles

- Viewer
 - Can only view the videos

- Creator
 - Can view and manage content in the areas they have access to.
- Administrator
 - Can view and manage all video and side-wide settings.

Sharing Settings

- Share a folder or a session by clicking the Share button
- Subfolders can have their own sharing settings or inherit from their Parent
- You can make a video viewable to wider audience or just to a small group



Access the Editor

- Click the pencil icon.
- Can access from the viewer or the library.

Tour of the Video Editor



Trim a section from your video!

- Click on scissors icon.
- Click and drag to cut a section.
- Click and drag on a secondary video source to cut just that source.
- Publish when finished.



Assignment Folders

- Student assignment folders allow students to submit video homework
- Create an assignment folder in the settings for a class folder
- All students who can view in the class folder will be able to create in the assignment folder automatically

An assignment folder is a subfolder that shares its user list with its parent folder, but gives the users some additional privileges.

Assignment folders enable Viewer users in their parent folder to create and manage their own content, while preventing them from viewing other users' content that has not been explicitly shared or made public.
