In the Department of Physical Therapy, we are currently studying walking in people who have had a stroke.

The study consists of a series of evaluations and up to 36 training sessions.

Who is eligible for the study?

We are looking for individuals 30-80 years old who meet the following criteria:

Have had
one stroke



- Weakness on one side
- Can walk *without* assistance from another person
- Can walk on a treadmill
- Do *not* take insulin for the control of diabetes
- Have *no* uncontrolled heart problems

What is involved?

If you are eligible and *want to* participate, the study includes:



- Detailed clinical evaluations
- State of the art walking training

All training is provided free of charge and compensation will be provided for participation in evaluation sessions
