Accomplishments and Progress in Reaching Goals and Fulfilling Plan

While Janet Louise was Chair, the library was reorganized with new categories created and with each book assigned a number according to its category. In addition, many new purchases were made. Walt Babich took over as Chair in July 2009. During the September retreat, 154 new titles were cataloged and placed on the shelves of the library in the Curtis Mansion at 189 West Main Street.

Since the September retreat, the Chair of the Committee and the Director of the ELI have discussed future purchasing procedures, the budget, and the new location of the main collection which will be housed in downtown Newark on East Main Street.

In addition, a DVD collection was purchased and added to the collection. This was the first addition to this new category of the collection.
