Student Health Center Fee is a mandatory fee on bill each semester for all full-time students.

This fee will provide you with unlimited visits to practitioners and nurse practitioners, all in-house laboratory work, all inpatient care in the infirmary, gynecology services including annual exams and Pap smears (thin preps), nutrition services, visits to the Sports Medicine Clinic, many immunizations and administration of allergy injections using serum provided by your allergist. The health fee also covers services offered by the <u>Center for</u> <u>Counseling and Student Development</u>. There are separate fees for x-rays, most medications and orthopedic supplies, and some immunizations.

Student Accident and Sickness Insurance Plan

The University sponsors a Student Accident and Sickness Insurance Plan, which offers substantial benefits for covered medical expenses at a relatively low cost for single students. Coverage is also available for a student's spouse and/or dependent children at an additional charge. You're urged to enroll in this plan if you have no other coverage, if your coverage expires during the academic year, or as a supplement to existing insurance coverage. Students from outside the United States are required to have either insurance offered by the University or equivalent insurance coverage.
