

**6,721 INCREASED Violations by 9%** 

Designed to protect employees working with a 6 feet or higher unprotected site.





## **HAZARD COMMUNICATION**

5,192 INCREASED Violations by <1%

Addresses hazards of chemicals both produced in and imported to the workplace.





### **SCAFFOLDING**

4,295 **INCREASED** Violations by 6%

Employers are required to protect construction workers' operation on scaffolding at 10 feet or higher.





### RESPIRATORY PROTECTION

3,305 INCREASED Violations by 2%

Guides employers on establishing or maintaining a respiratory protection program.



## LOCKOUT/TAGOUT

3,002 INCREASED Violations by 10%


Control of hazardous energy during servicing and maintenance of machines and equipment.



# POWERED INDUSTRIAL TRUCKS

2,760 INCREASED Violations by 4%


Design, maintenance and operation of powered industrial trucks, forklifts and motorized hand trucks.



## **LADDERS**

2,489 **INCREASED** Violations by 2%

Covers general requirements for all ladders.







## MACHINE GUARDING

2,295 INCREASED Violations by 4%

Guarding of machinery to protect operators and other employees from hazards.
