DOWNWARD TREND VS. PREVIOUS YEAR

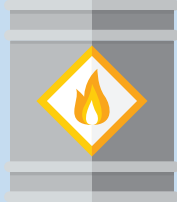

FALL PROTECTION

6,721 **INCREASED** Violations by 9%
Designed to protect employees working with a 6 feet or higher unprotected site.

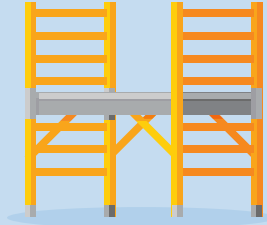

HAZARD COMMUNICATION

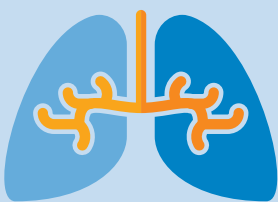
5,192 **INCREASED** Violations by <1%
Addresses hazards of chemicals both produced in and imported to the workplace.

SCAFFOLDING

4,295 **INCREASED** Violations by 6%
Employers are required to protect construction workers' operation on scaffolding at 10 feet or higher.



RESPIRATORY PROTECTION

3,305 **INCREASED** Violations by 2%
Guides employers on establishing or maintaining a respiratory protection program.

LOCKOUT/TAGOUT

3,002 **INCREASED** Violations by 10%
Control of hazardous energy during servicing and maintenance of machines and equipment.

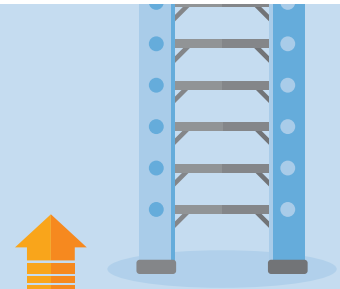

POWERED INDUSTRIAL TRUCKS

2,760 **INCREASED** Violations by 4%
Design, maintenance and operation of powered industrial trucks, forklifts and motorized hand trucks.

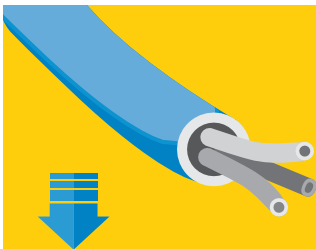

LADDERS

2,489 **INCREASED** Violations by 2%
Covers general requirements for all ladders.

ELECTRICAL WIRING METHODS

2,404 **DECREASED** Violations by 4%
Grounding of electrical equipment, wiring and insulation. Also includes temporary wiring and splicing.

MACHINE GUARDING

2,295 **INCREASED** Violations by 4%
Guarding of machinery to protect operators and other employees from hazards.

ELECTRICAL, GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1,973 **DECREASED** Violations by 4%
Safety requirements for designing electrical systems.
