- 1. What major themes appearing in John Locke's Second Treatise can also be found in Thomas Paine's Common Sense?
- 2. What major "Enlightenment" principles thrived and hence were incorporated into the "Founding Period" of the American Constitution?
- 3. The "Articles of Confederation' were abandoned after only seven years. What was wrong with our first constitution?
- 4. James Madison at first opposed a Bill of Rights in part because he believed that a "well constructed Union" would protect individual freedom against "tyranny of the majority." What structural factors of the new Constitution protect against such tyranny? [He discusses this in the Federalist papers.]
