### Feature – Functions

1	Three multi-color LED indicators provide call status information:
	<ul> <li>Off: Ready, Call State Off</li> <li>Solid amber: Powering On</li> <li>Solid red: Powering On, Mute, or Voice Message</li> <li>Flashing red: Hold</li> <li>Solid green: Dial Tone, Dialing, or Connected</li> <li>Flashing green: Incoming Call</li> </ul>
	(Ringing/Connecting), or Receiving
2	Microphones-Three internal unidirectional microphones
3	Speaker
4	Navigation ButtonAllows the user to scroll through menus and highlight items.
5	Select ButtonActivates the currently highlighted screen menu option.
6	Disconnect ButtonEnds Current Call.
7	Raises the volume of the speaker (off-hook) and the ringer (on-hook).
8	Lowers the volume of the speaker (off-hook) and the ringer (on-hook).
9	Toggles the Mute feature.

## Feature – Functions - "Continued"

10	Dial PadAllows the user to dial phone numbers.
11	Redial Button Dials the most recent number you called.
12	Directory ButtonAccess to the Directories menu.
13	Application ButtonAccess the Messages, Settings, and Services menus.
14	<ul> <li>Allows the user to go off-hook to:</li> <li>Invoke a dial tone</li> <li>Obtain a dial tone to initiate a call</li> <li>Initiate a call after you enter a phone number</li> <li>Answer an incoming call</li> <li>View certain soft keys</li> </ul>
15	Allows the user to select soft key options that display on the screen.
16	Displays conference station menus and features.
