### Responses to External Threats

1. **Absorbing the foreign**
  - a. Rangaku and accommodation of the new. Examples:  
Sugita Genpaku (1733-1817); Maeno Ryōtaku (1723-1803)  
Sakuma Shōzan (1811-1864)
2. **Expelling the foreign**
  - a. Kokugaku and proto-nationalism  
Motoori Norinaga (1730-1801); Hirata Atsutane (1776-1843)
  - b. Mitogaku and the Expulsion Edict of 1825  
**Fujita Yūkoku (1774-1826); Aizawa Seishisai (1781-1863)**
    - ninennaku uchiharai (fire on and repel without hesitation)
3. **News of The Opium War in China, early 1840s**
4. **Western envoys**
  - a. US-Japan Treaty of Friendship (Kanagawa Treaty), 1854
  - b. Shimoda and Hakodate opened for provisioning
  - c. Townsend Harris and US-Japan Treaty of Amity & Commerce (others follow)
  - d. Extraterritoriality and unequal treaties
