DIRECTIONS TO BUILDINGS

(see below)

Broomall PA meetinghouse: To get to the Broomall building, take I-95 north to I-476 (Blue Route) north. Take Exit 5 (Rte 1), then stay to the right to go north on Rte 320. At Paxon Hollow Road, turn left, and the building is about a half-mile along on the left. From the Newark building, the Broomall building is about a 40 minute drive, depending on traffic. The address is 721 Paxon Hollow Road, Broomall, PA

Newark DE Meetinghouse: The Newark meetinghouse is about a 40 minute drive from Broomall, 50 minutes from 39th and Chestnut, 35 minutes from the Woodstown building. Take I-95 south to the last exit in Delaware, Rte. 896. Take 896 north (South College Avenue) to the second light (just past the McDonald's), where you turn left by going through the light, then right around the jug handle. You are now going west on West Chestnut Hill Road. Go up the hill, then down the hill, about a mile, and the building will be on your right, 500 West Chestnut Hill Road. If you get to the light at Ott's Chapel Road, you have gone 50 yards too far. The address is 500 West Chestnut Hill Road, Newark, DE

Cherry Hill NJ Meetinghouse: From any bridge over the Delaware River proceed to I-295. Take Exit 32 off of I-295 for County Highway 561 (Berlin Road) East toward Gibbsboro/Voorhees. Follow on Berlin Road 1.7 miles to the intersection with Evesham Road which has a traffic light. Take a hard right (this is a 5-point intersection) onto Evesham Ave and go 1/10th of a mile. The Cherry Hill meetinghouse will be on your right. The address is 252 East Evesham Ave, Cherry Hill, NJ 08003

Travel times from the bridges:

Delaware Memorial Bridge - 35 minutes, Commodore Barry Bridge - 28 minutes, Walt Whitman Bridge - 15, minutes, Ben Franklin Bridge - 19 minutes, Betsy Ross Bridge - 20 minutes.

39th **and Chestnut: 3913 Chestnut Street, Philadelphia, PA, 1910** Home of the Philadelphia 3rd (YSA) Ward. Take Rte 76 (Schuykill Expressway) to University Avenue. Follow the road around until it goes under an underpass and Civic Center Blvd goes off to the right at the light. At the next light, turn left on Baltimore Ave (Rte 13). Turn right on 41st Street, and go 6 blocks to Chestnut. Turn right. The parking lot and building will be a block along on the left.
