- 2. In the event of a true emergency, administrators and persons with information about the cause and special needs shall proceed to the Public Safety vehicle with the rotating green light and wait for emergency responders.
- 3. All others must exit to a distance of 200 feet from the building to allow the safe arrival of emergency response vehicles.

When true emergencies occur, evacuation may be required for several minutes to several hours before the incident is resolved and the building is safe to reoccupy. Practicing these procedures should help you remember to carry your vehicle keys with you so you will be prepared when an emergency occurs.
