Laboratory Gloves: Disposal Guidance

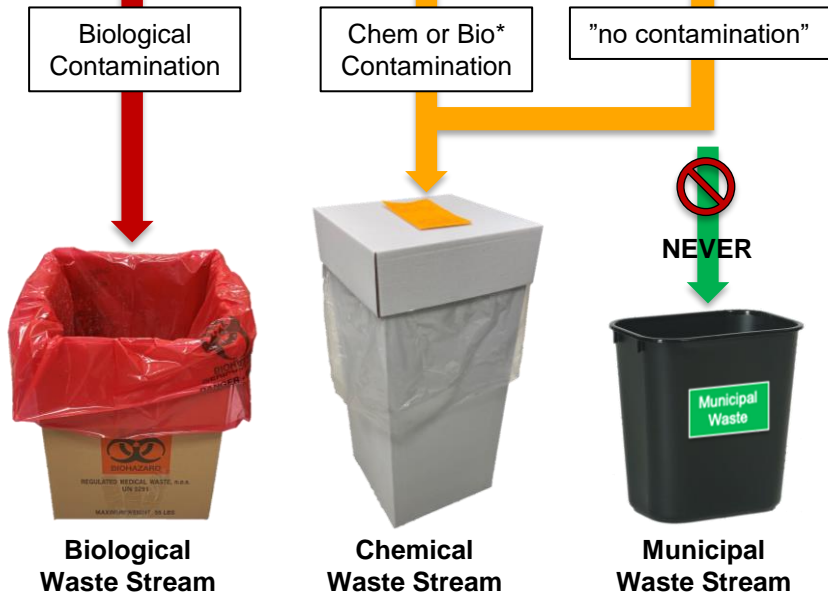


Gloves in Lab

When using gloves in a laboratory, it is important to dispose of them properly. Gloves must be placed in a biological waste or chemical lab trash box and never in regular municipal trash. Never reuse single-use gloves!

*Place pathogenic contaminants in biowaste.

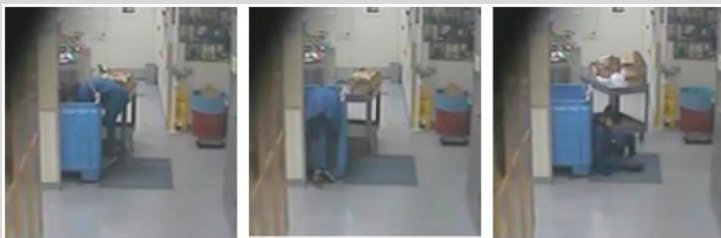
Contamination Type

Asphyxiation Hazard Associated with Dry Ice

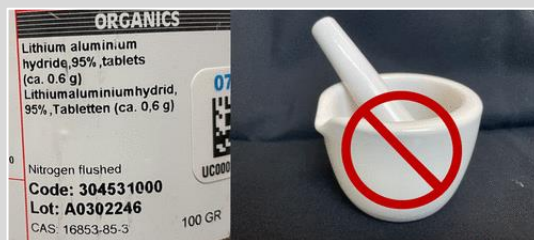
