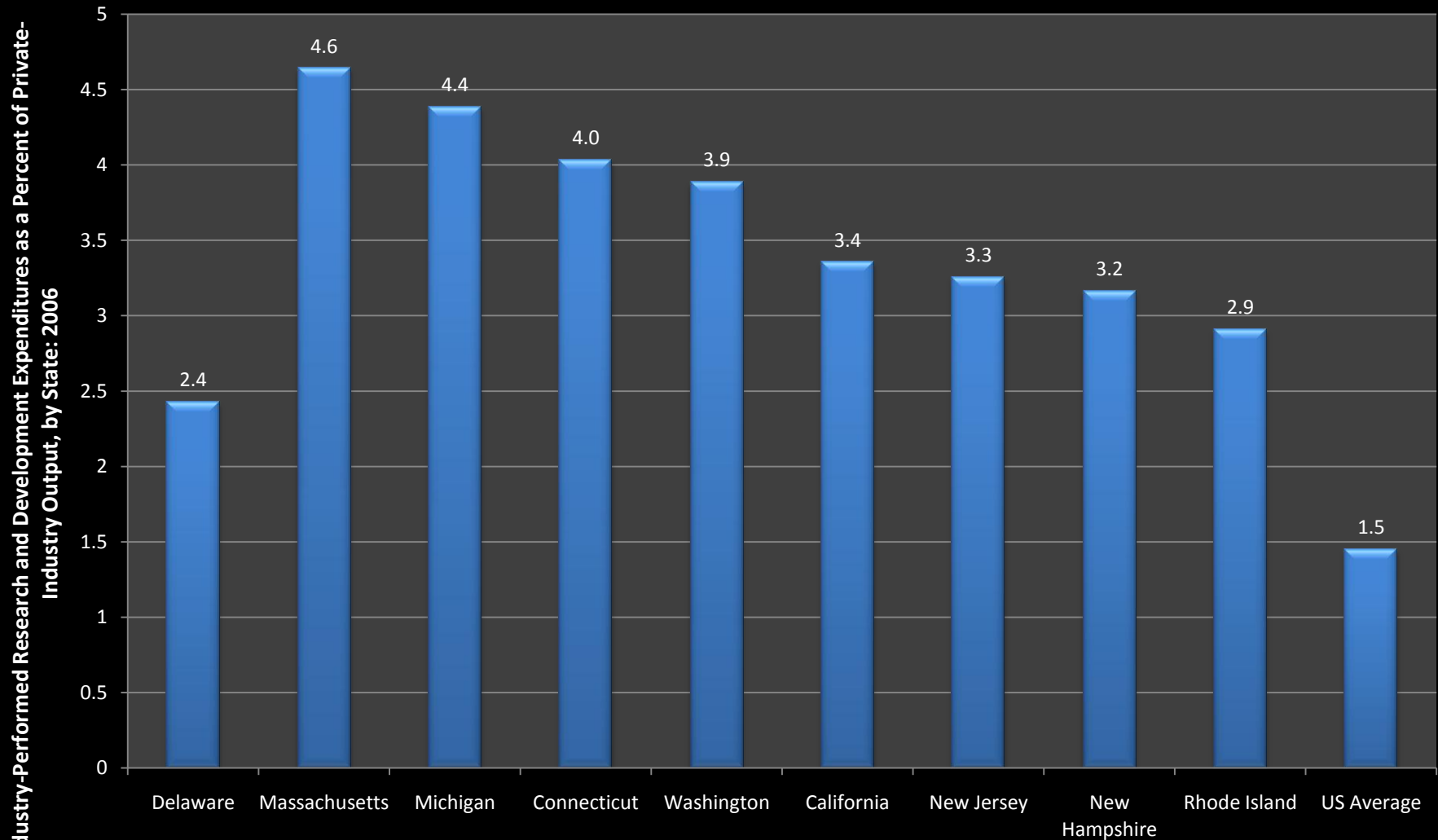

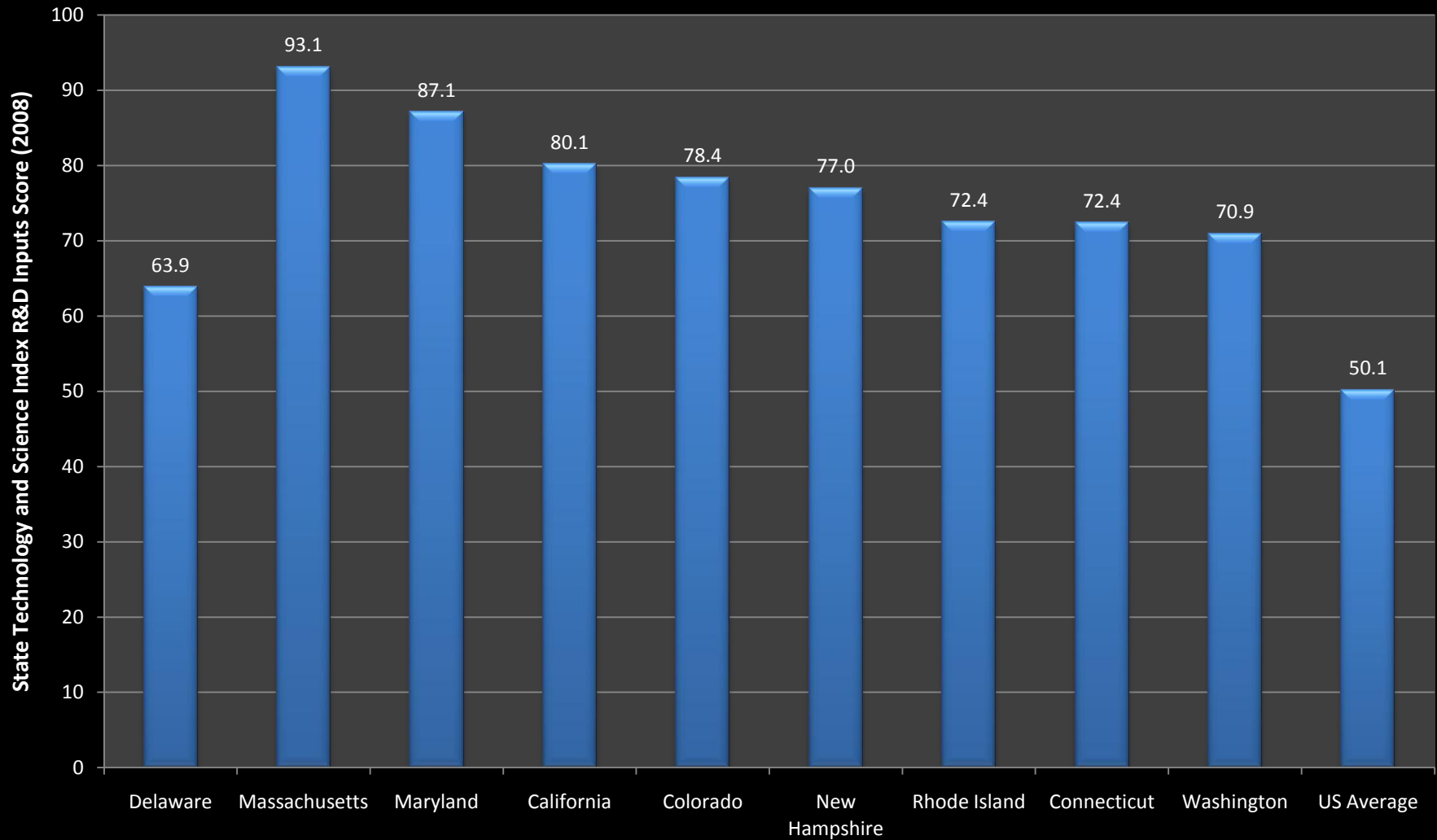

# Industrial Research and Development as Percent of Output (Top 8 States Compared to Delaware ) Delaware's rank is 10



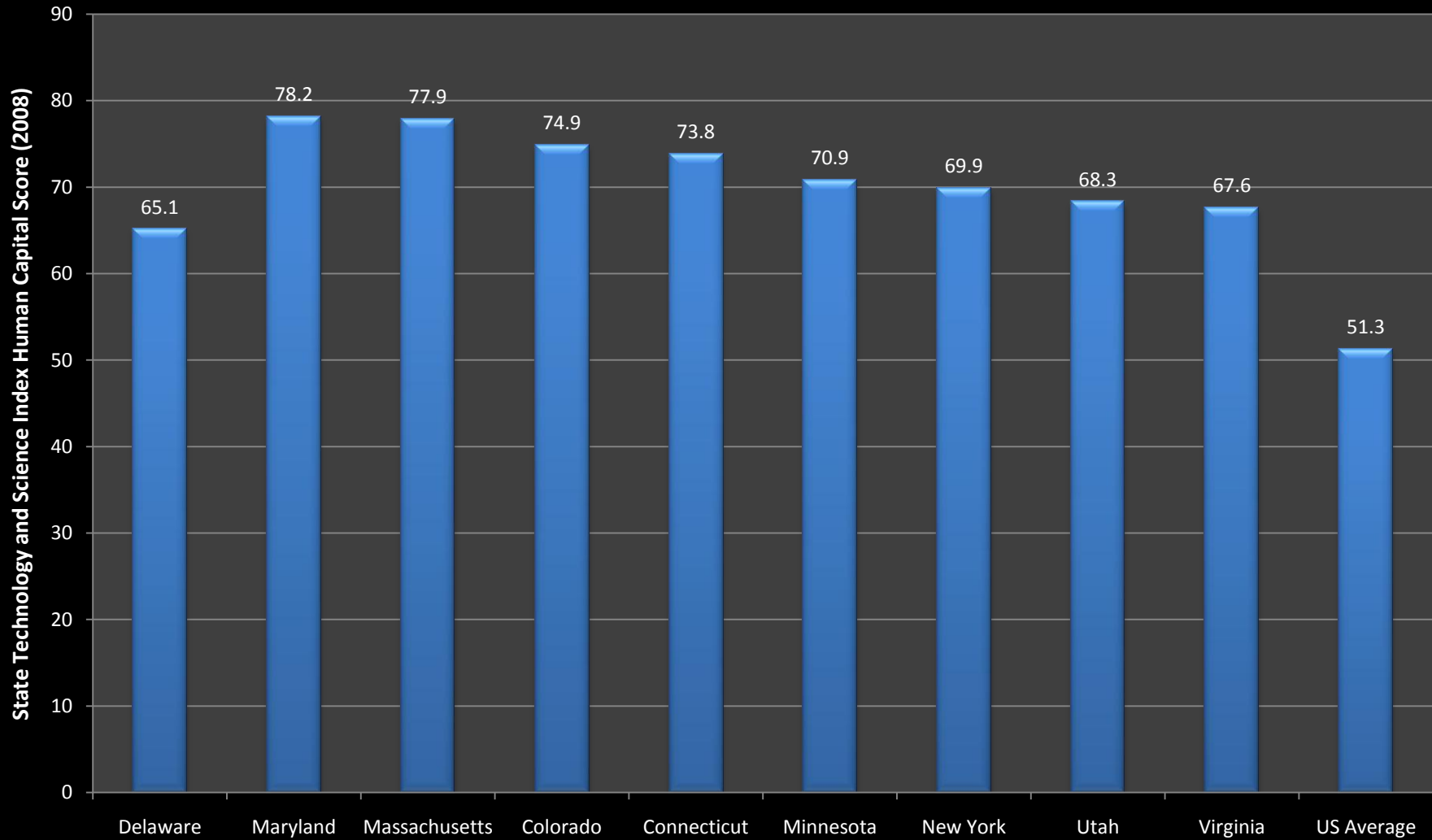

# State Technology and Science Index for R&D Inputs (Milken Institute) (Top 8 States Compared to Delaware ) Delaware's rank is 12



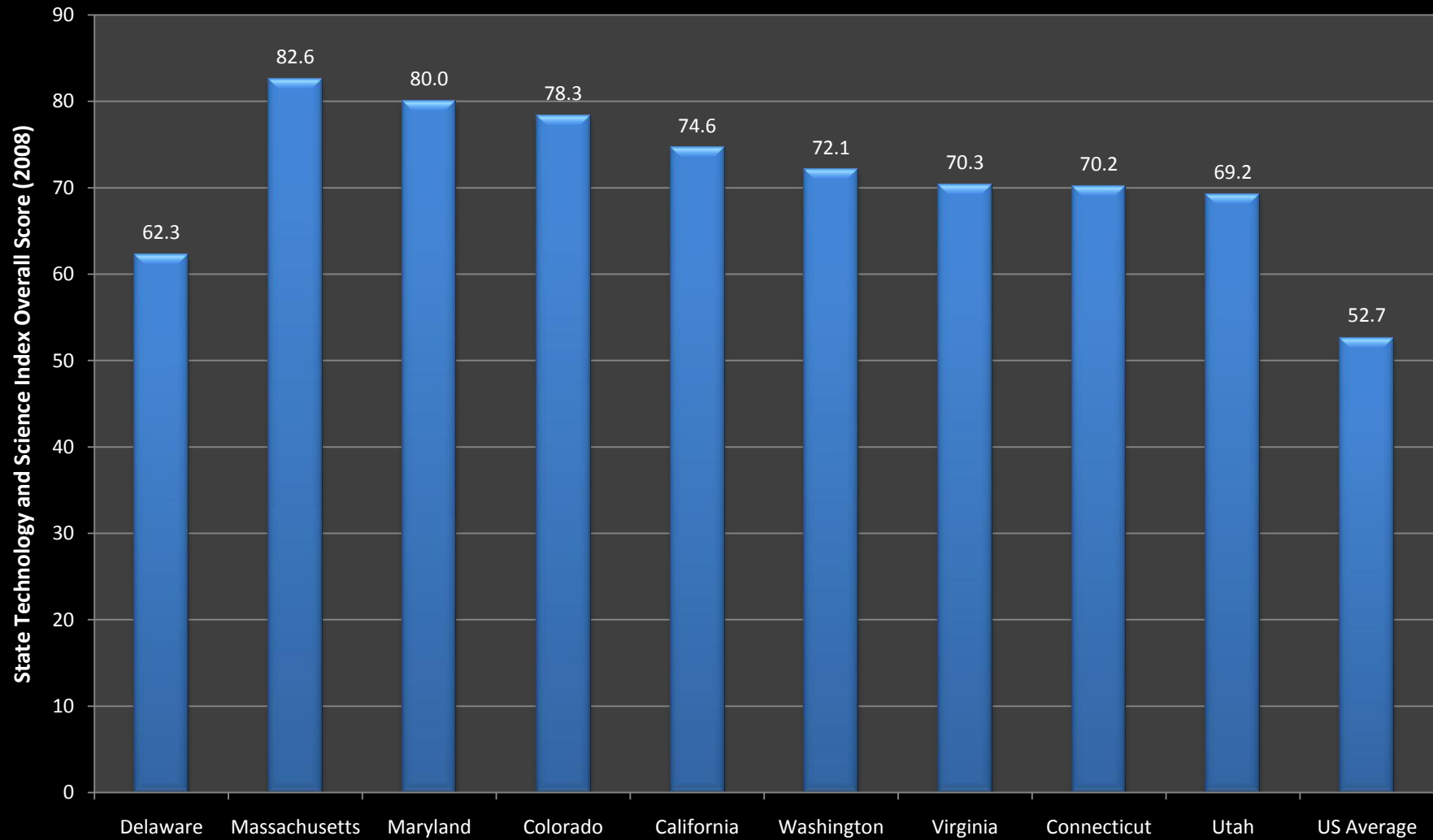
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# State Technology and Science Index for Human Capital (Milken Institute) (Top 8 States Compared to Delaware ) Delaware's rank is 10



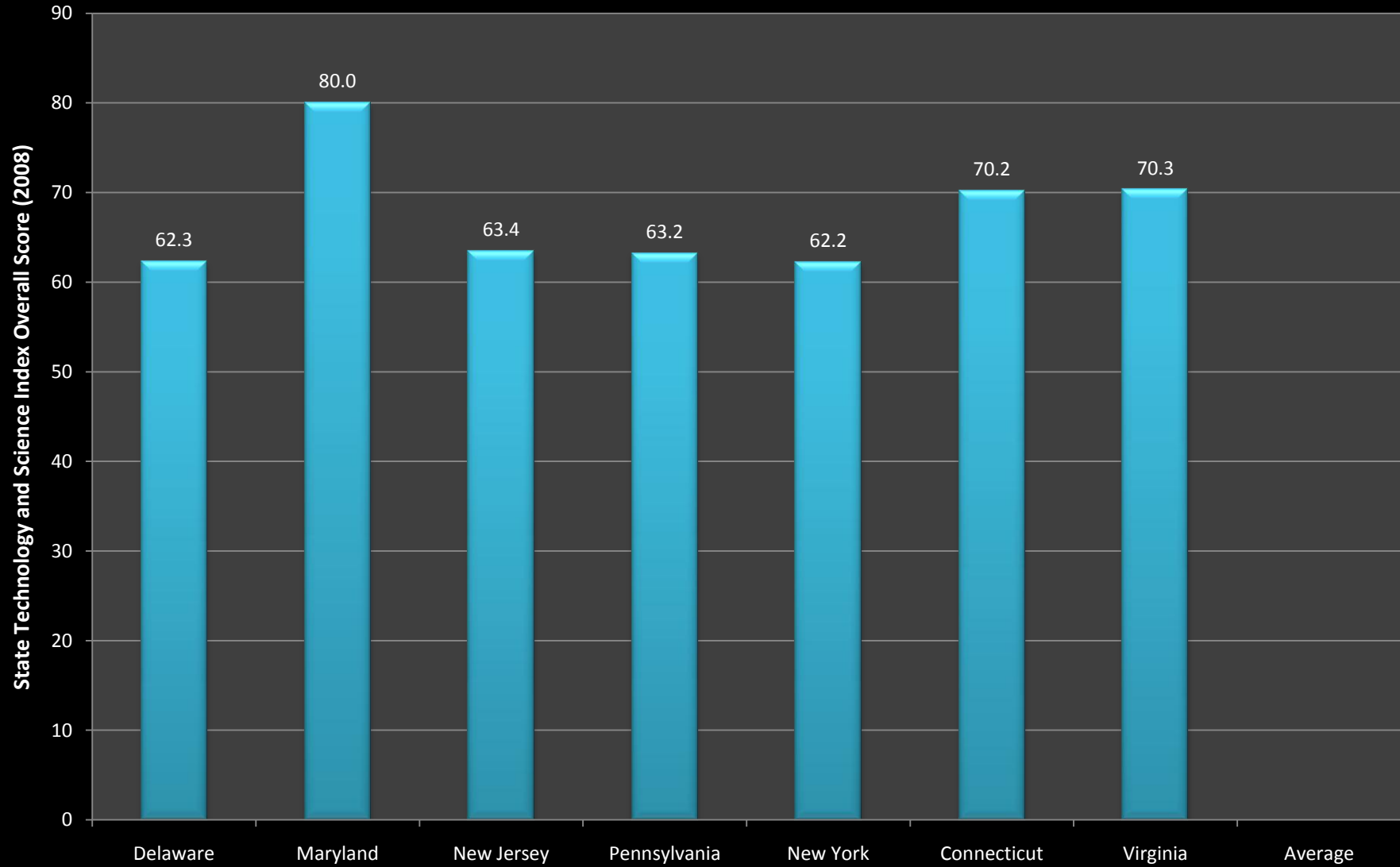
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# State Technology and Science Index (Milken Institute) (Top 8 States Compared to Delaware ) Delaware's rank is 14



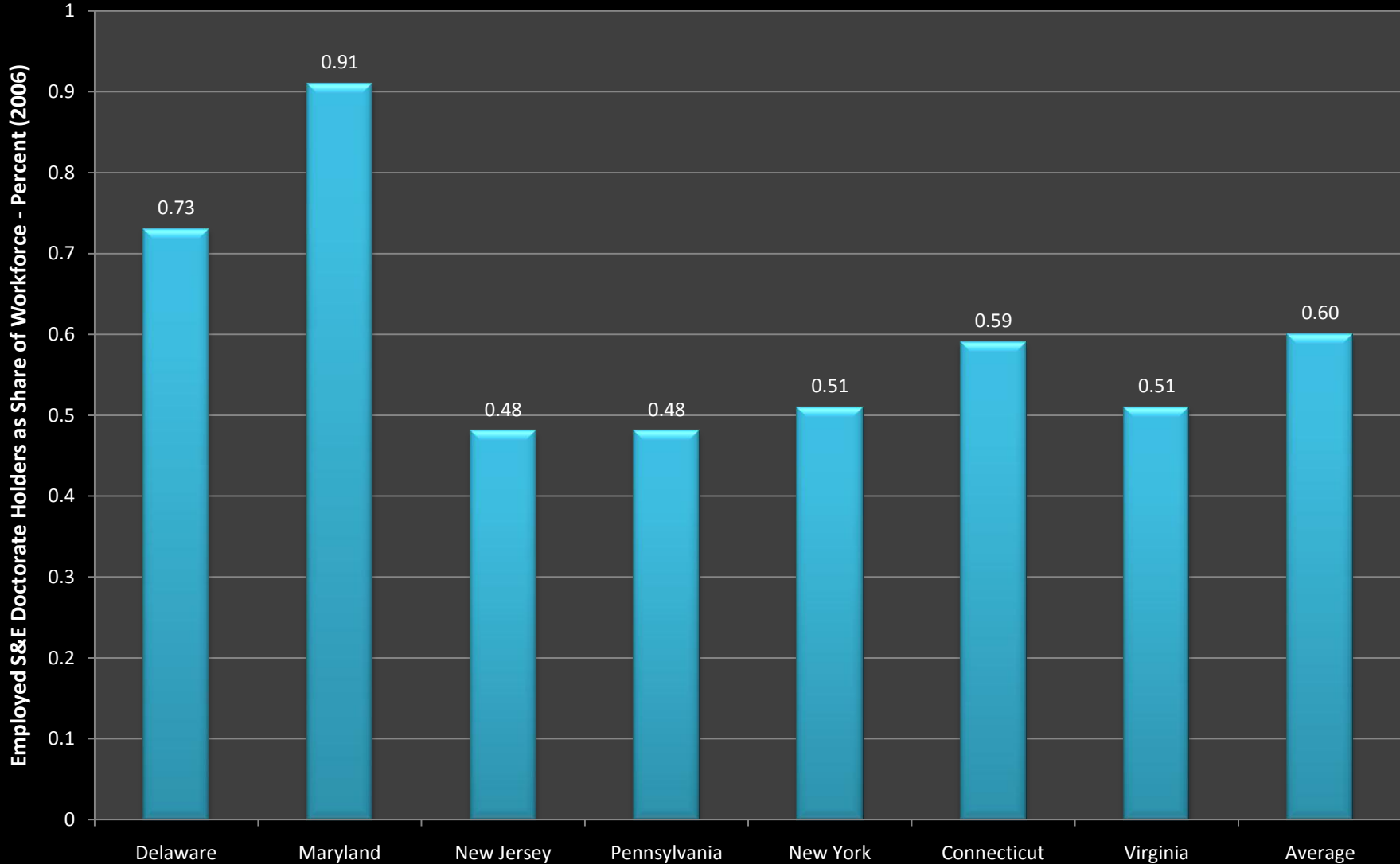
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## State Technology and Science Index (Milken Institute) Mid-Atlantic Region



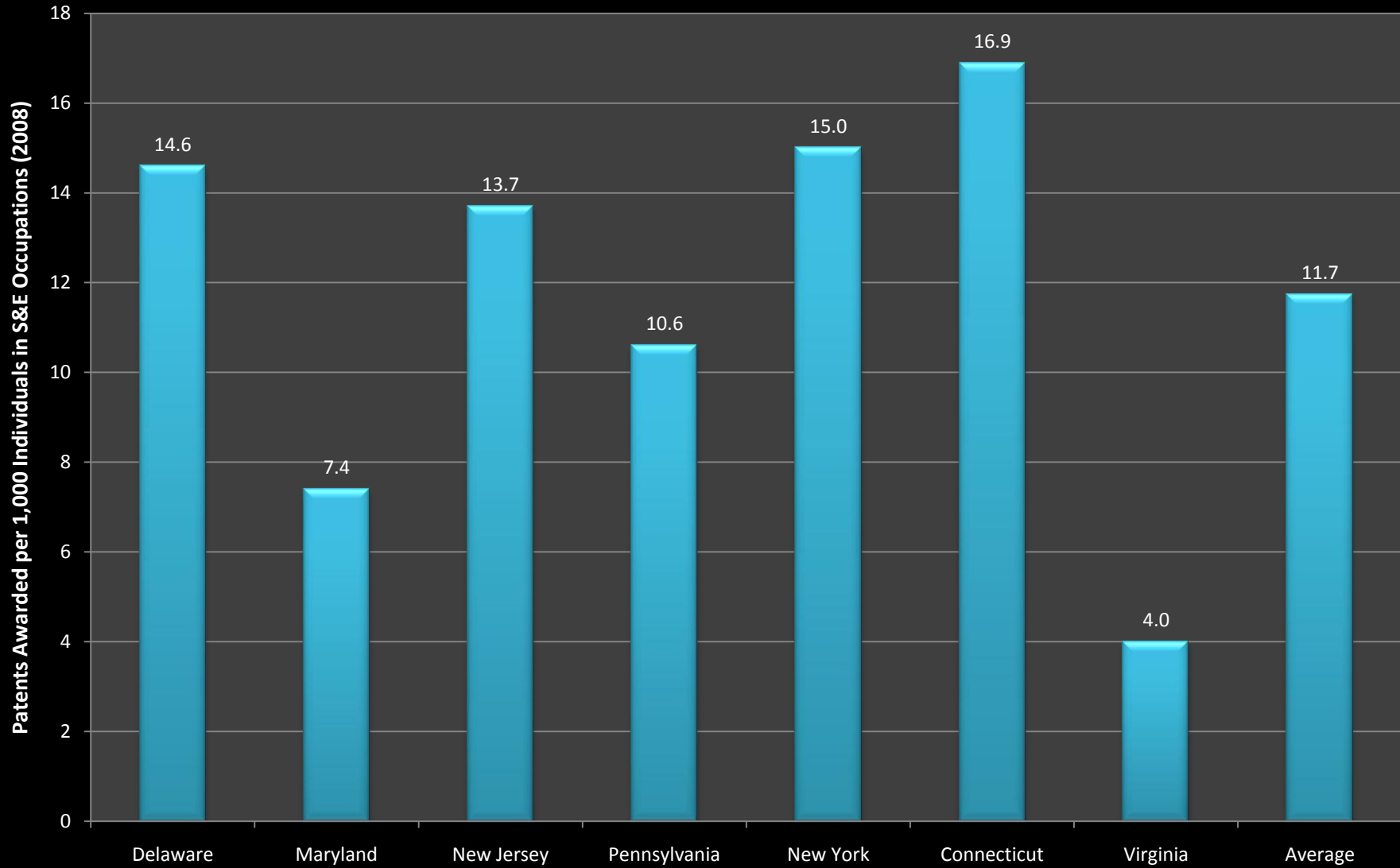
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# Employed S&E Doctorate Holders as Percent of the Workforce Mid-Atlantic

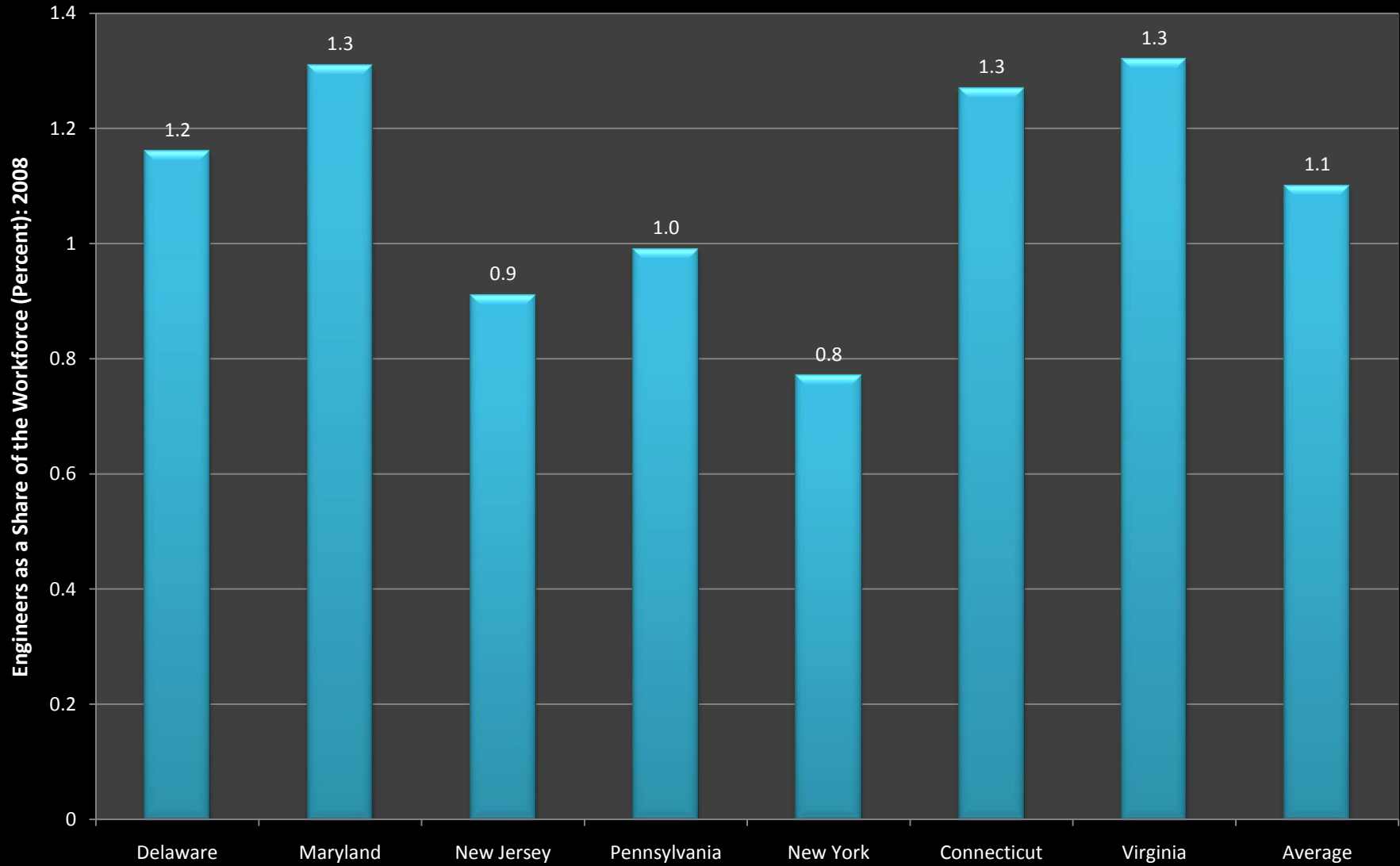
## Patents Awarded per 1,000 Individuals in S&E Jobs Mid-Atlantic

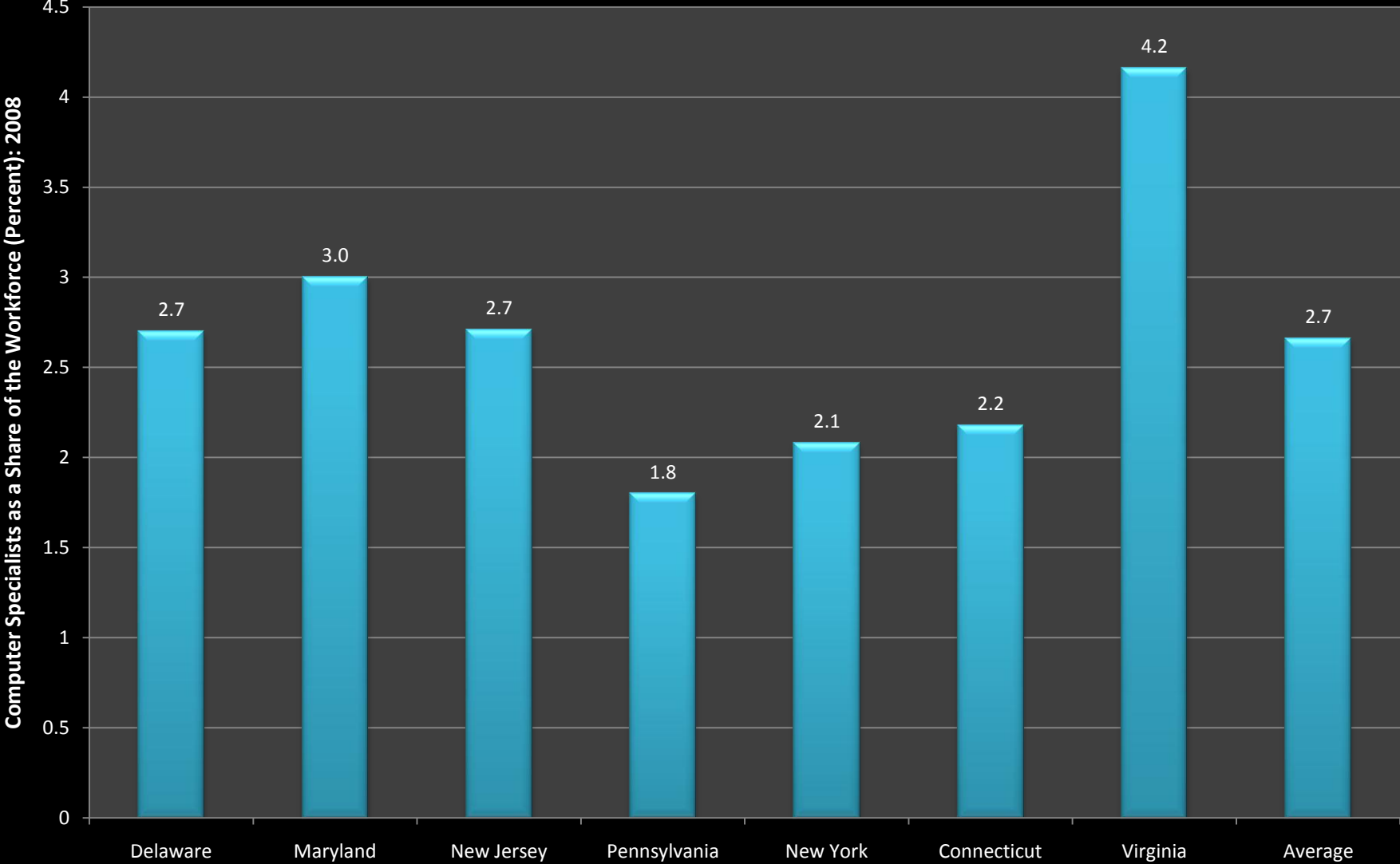


## Engineers as a Percent of the Workforce Mid-Atlantic



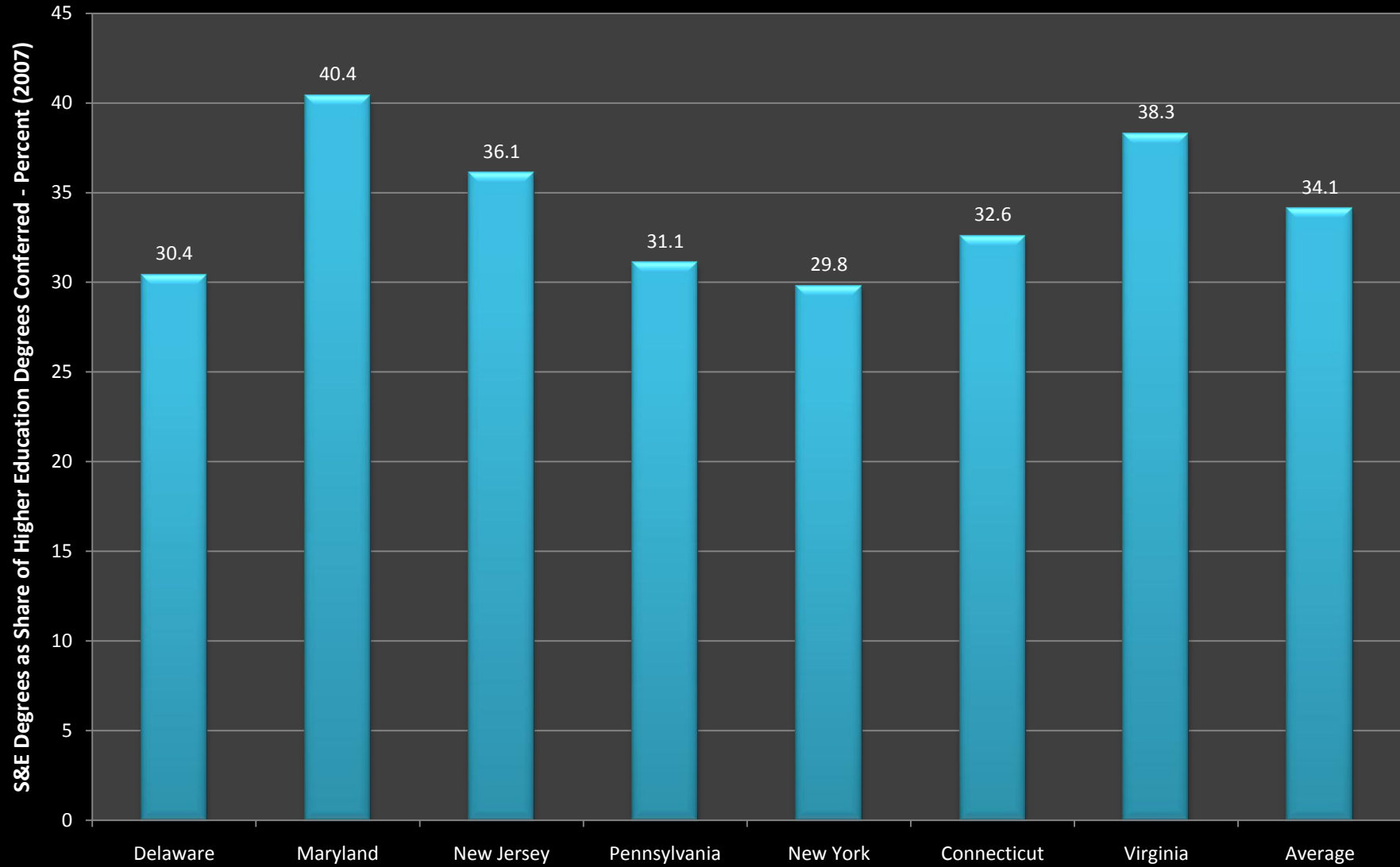

# Computer Specialists as a Percent of the Workforce Mid-Atlantic



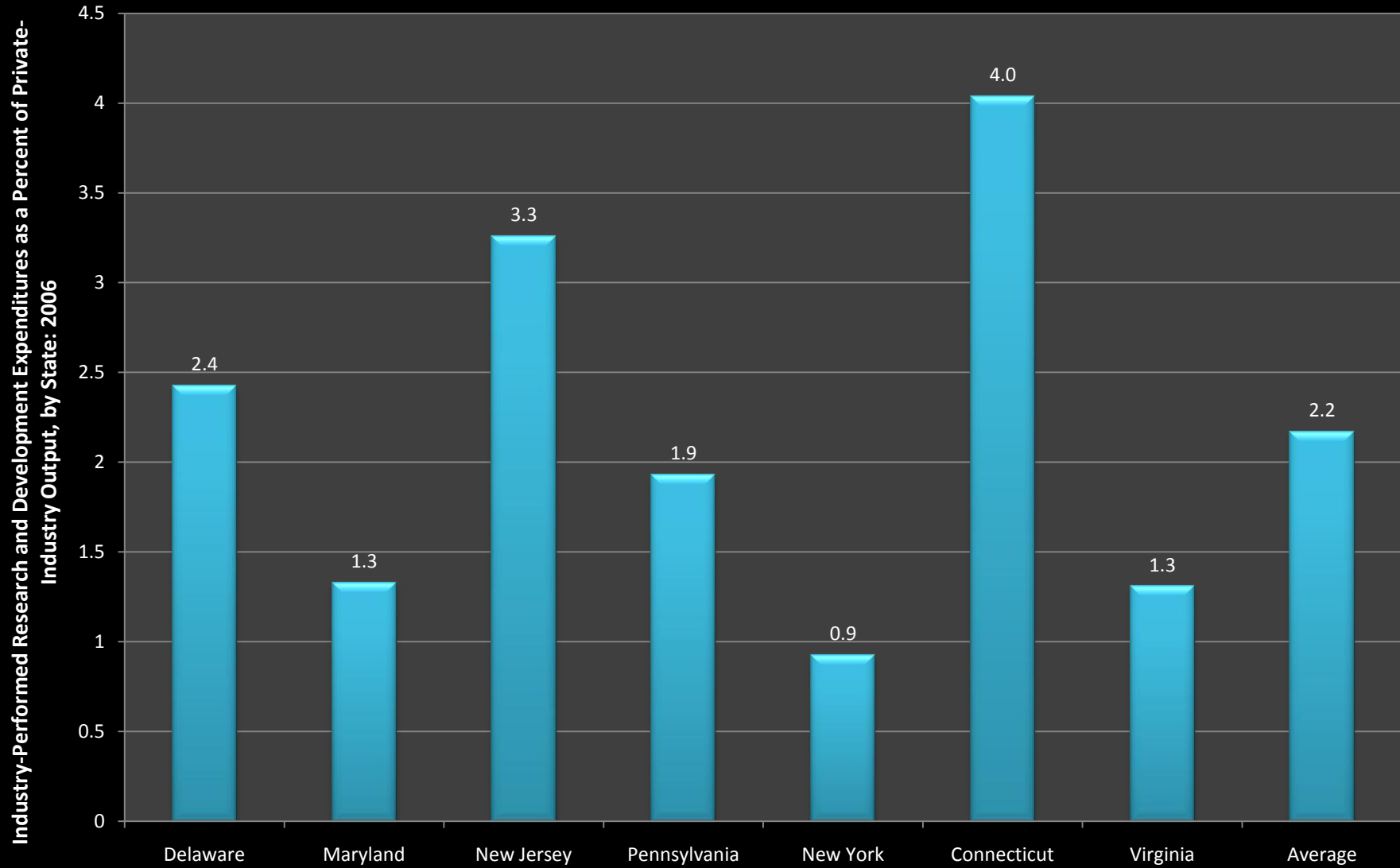
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## S&E Degrees as a Percent of Higher Education Degrees Mid-Atlantic
