AWARD DESCRIPTIONS

Cheryl Wormser Trevithick Scholarship - Cheryl's Gift

This award was established in memory of Cheryl Wormser Trevithick, an alumna who graduated in 1986 as an Elementary Teacher Education major from the School of Education. The scholarship is awarded to students majoring in Elementary Teacher Education on the basis of both academic merit and genuine financial need. Preference is given to candidates who demonstrate integrity of character and service to the community.

College of Education and Human Development Panel of Outstanding Doctoral Students

This award recognizes doctoral students from each department/school in the College of Education and Human Development. Selection is based upon evidence of positive working relationship with faculty and students, demonstration of leadership in the College or outside professional work and potential for contribution to the students' chosen field.

College of Education and Human Development Panel of Outstanding Master's Students

This award recognizes master's students from each department/school in the College of Education and Human Development. Selection is based upon evidence of positive working relationship with faculty and students, demonstration of leadership in the College or outside professional work and potential for contribution to students' chosen field.

First State Constitutional Scholarship

The goal of this scholarship is to promote and enhance the teaching of civics in Delaware schools by encouraging outstanding Elementary

Teacher Education students to concentrate in the area of social studies. Recipients are freshmen from Delaware who are pursuing the middle school social studies concentration.

Frank B. Murray Award for Excellence in Graduate Research

This award is presented to a doctoral candidate in the School of Education whose work demonstrates the qualities of thoughtfulness and leadership that have been characterized by Frank B. Murray's tenure as Dean of the College of Education, 1979-1995.

Judy Cohen Schwartz Award

This award is given to an Early Childhood Education student or Elementary Teacher Education student who is pursuing the special education concentration. Students who are committed to a career working with people with developmental disabilities will receive preference. Given to a student who demonstrates financial need.

Mathematics Education Award

This award is presented to an undergraduate and graduate student in the School of Education who has shown outstanding scholarship and promise in the field of mathematics education.

Outstanding Student Teacher Award

This award is presented to outstanding student teachers who have demonstrated their abilities to function as scholars, problem solvers and partners in a classroom environment. They demonstrate these abilities by planning and implementing exceptional lessons, developing rapport with children and/or adolescents, colleagues, and parents and incorporating suggestions and new ideas into their best teaching practices.

Pearl and Oscar Bregman Award

This award honoring the memory of Pearl K. Bregman, a graduate of the agency counseling psychology program of the former College of Education, is to be given to a graduate student whose research has the potential of improving the lives of children and adolescents.

Phi Delta Kappa Award

This award is presented to a senior undergraduate teacher education student who shows evidence and promise of excellence in educational research.

Richard L. Venezky Award for Creative Research in Literacy

This award is presented to a master's or doctoral student in the School of Education who has done the most creative work in the area of literacy research over the past year.

Robert W. Stegner Award

This award is presented to a senior or graduate student in the School of Education who has demonstrated the outstanding qualities that characterized the late Dr. Stegner: dedication to the teaching profession, a comprehension of the breadth and depth of the science content area and excellence in teaching.

School of Education Excellence in Academic Achievement Award

This award recognizes the freshman, sophomore, junior and senior in the School of Education who has achieved the highest cumulative index in their graduating class.

School of Education Distinguished Faculty Award

This award is presented to a full-time faculty member in the School of Education to recognize outstanding achievement in research, teaching and/or service that is clearly beyond the expectations of the position.

Second Mile Award

This award is presented by the School of Education to an individual in recognition and appreciation of exemplary support and service to the field of education.

Susan McLaughlin Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded annually to a student in the College of Education and Human Development who demonstrated outstanding character, motivation, discipline and promise in the pursuit of their undergraduate degree. Given to a student who demonstrates financial need.

Victor Mankin Award

This award is in memory of Victor Mankin, formerly a faculty member in the School Counseling Program. It is presented to a second-year school psychology graduate student who has demonstrated academic excellence and outstanding potential as an education professional.

Wallace H. Maw Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a student in the College of Education and Human Development who demonstrates financial need.

William B. Keene Scholarship

This award is presented to a sophomore or junior education major in the College of Education and Human Development who exhibits exceptional promise as a future educator.
